Spectators	<p>Indoor Events-6 Spectators per home athlete, 2 spectators per visiting athlete, 2 spectators per coach of home and visiting team, 2 spectators per manager</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tickets for EACH game will be dispersed by the athlete, coach, or manager • Entry will not be allowed without a ticket • In the event of a boys/girls doubleheader for basketball, the gym will be cleared of spectators after one gender completes all levels of play (If you are a ticket holder for both, only one entry fee will be required)
Screening	Spectators should self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms before attending an event.
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Spectators should sit together in family groups and not intermingle before, during, and after the event. • Maintain 6 feet of physical distancing of people outside your family group at entry, during the event, and upon exit of the facilities.
Face Coverings	Face Coverings will be required per the Governor’s Directive
Occupancy	<p>Indoor Events-Not to exceed 50% capacity of HS Gym (250 persons)-Tickets will not be sold beyond the 250 capacity limit regardless of team roster size</p>
