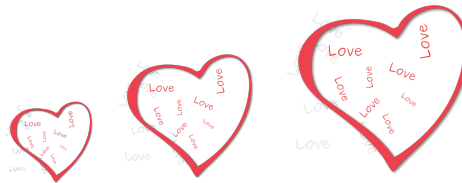

<p>Horatio Alger Scholarship</p> <p>Juniors</p>	<p>The eligibility criteria to be considered for this \$20,000 National Scholarship are as follows:</p> <p>Enrollment full time as a high school junior, progressing normally toward graduation in the Spring/Summer 2022, with plans to enter college no later than the fall following graduation; a strong commitment to pursuing and completing a <u>bachelor's degree</u> at an accredited institution located in the United States (students may start their studies at a two-year institution and then transfer to a four-year institution. <b>Idaho, Louisiana, and Montana state scholarship recipients must pursue and complete a degree at specific colleges and universities. <p>Hagan Scholarship Foundation Scholarship</p>	<p>This is a nationwide, need based, merit scholarship for high achieving students who require financial assistance in order to attend college. 350 scholarships will be awarded each year. Criteria: 3.5 GPA, ACT score or 23 or higher or SAT score of 1200 or higher, enrolling in a four year college in the fall of 2019, must work 240 hours in the twelve months prior to the start of each academic year, EFC must be less than \$6500, must apply for Federal and State grants, and must not have been convicted of a felony.
