Thompson Falls High School is located in Thompson Falls-the heart of the Clark Fork Valley which has a population of about 1,350 people. Nestled in the Rocky Mountains, Thompson Falls lies in a quiet valley along the beautiful Clark Fork River and serves as the county seat. The town was established in 1885 during the gold and silver mining era. Thompson Falls is situated in Northwest Montana along Highway 200 next to the Idaho border and is approximately 100 miles north of Missoula, Montana.
