The general consensus was that our mission is best served by continuing with our current arrangement of a K-6 elementary school and 7-8 junior high on the elementary campus and having a 912 high school on the other campus. We did discover that we could move grades 7 \& 8 to the high school campus but would not realize a significant savings. This is a realistic option in case of an emergency or if the high school population drops below 150 students. $5-8$ middle school and $6-8$ junior high were also explored but did not prove to be a more effective or efficient use of our resources.
